Categories of Prescribed Therapies Involving the Practice of Psychotherapy Regulation Submission Update

The draft regulation was submitted to the Minister of Health on June 29, 2018, in accordance with the deadline set by the Minister. The Controlled Act Task Group (CATG) met in early September to discuss 'next steps' in the dissemination of the controlled act consultation documents. The CATG agreed in principle on a three-pronged approach:

- 1. Letter thanking stakeholders for participation & articulating our next steps in summary
- 2. Practical 'internal' usage of each component incorporating self-assessment tool into the registration process
- 3. Practical 'external usage' to follow in cooperation with government's work on the implementation

The CATG will reconvene as needed and staff will disseminate the documents through the Registration Committee and communication with members and will incorporate in other areas, as required (e.g. jurisprudence). The final controlled act consultation documents can be found here.

Election of Officers

In accordance with the CRPO by-laws pertaining to the election of officers, "the Executive Committee shall be composed of the President, the Vice-President and three (3) members of Council. Three (3) members of the Executive Committee shall be Members and two (2) members of the Executive Committee shall be Public Members." When there is only one nominee for a position, that person shall be elected via acclamation.
