Committee appointments

Council approved the Executive Committee's recommendation to appoint Henry Pateman, public member, to the Registration Committee. H. Pateman was appointed to Council on March 4, 2022. Council also appointed H. Pateman to the Nominations and Elections Committee and Jeffrey Vincent, public member, to the Quality Assurance Committee.

Council Evaluation Framework

Council reviewed the Council Effectiveness Survey Report. The report is included in the <u>Council</u> <u>meeting materials</u>. Direction was provided to staff and the Executive Committee to develop the individual assessments for the final phases of the evaluation framework.

Proposed By-law Revisions

The proposed by-law changes relate to the election process. Changes are summarized as follows:

- Shorten the timeline stages between nominations and elections
- Reduce the number of RP signatories a candidate needs to be nominated
